- This bandsaw has the unequivocal support of timber framers for its accuracy and ease of cutting curves. Built around a tubular design, with sturdy cast-aluminum frame components, the saw blades can be tensioned to the correct maximum without flexing the frame. That enables the ZS 20 to execute clean and perfectly square cuts.
- The motor of the ZS 20 is a proven, robust and most powerful of design, providing high torque to match the strain of the tensioned blade. The switch uses a mechanical interlock before start up for additional safety measure. This switch can also be hard wired to enable the saw to reverse direction of the blade. That will increase the radius of cuts.
- A robust frame, a large table with two position markers, provide clear view of the scribe line. Aluminum wheels with vulcanized and polished rubber tires, dynamically balanced with sway-dampening wheel springs, 4 wear resistant carbide blade guides makes the saw blade turn quietly, yet aggressively through the wood.
- A perfect machine with optional accessories: a trolley cart for storage, a wall or trolley mounted telescopic arm and a variety of blades.
- Be it mortising, planing, sawing, routing: HEMA stands for quality of timber framing tools.
